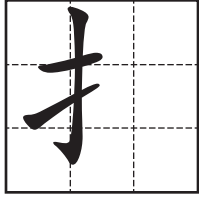
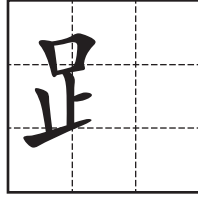


# Bits & Pieces: *Body Parts*

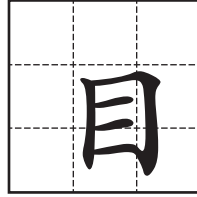

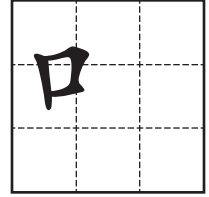
hand
