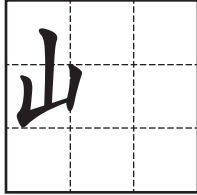
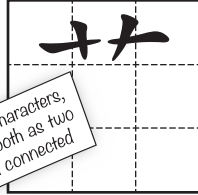


Bits & Pieces: Nature

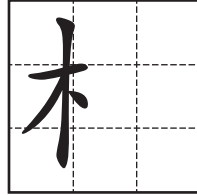

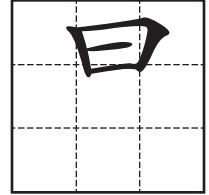
mountain
